



Art Fair – Artist Application Deadline to Apply: April 30, 2021

The fourth annual Garfield Park Art & Music Festival (GPAMF) will be held on Saturday, June 26 from 4-10 PM at the Garfield Park MacAllister Amphitheater and will feature local artists and musicians from Indianapolis. To be considered for the art fair that will be held as part of the festival, **reply to GPAC@Indy.Gov with the following information:**

1. Artist name and business name (if applicable)
2. Email address and phone number of main contact
3. A short bio/artist statement
4. 5-6 images of work you intend to sell (in JPEG or PNG format)
5. Link to website and/or social media (if applicable)
6. 2-3 images of booth setup (if applicable)

Guidelines to be considered for the festival lineup:

1. Artists who are Indianapolis-based or from the surrounding counties only, please.
2. Be available on Saturday, June 26 from 4-10 PM for the festival, plus additional setup and teardown time as needed for (more information to be provided to selected artists). Artists who teardown early or show up late will be banned from future events.
3. Only original, handmade artwork by the artist is allowed (includes prints of original artwork).

4. Provide your own pop-up tent (no deep stakes), tables, chair, table coverings, etc. for a 10x10 booth space. No access to electricity.
5. Pay \$30 for booth fee by deadline (to be provided to selected artists).
6. Comply with CDC recommendations as outlined in our COVID-19 safety plan (see below).
7. Be willing to promote on behalf of the festival.
8. Any artwork with racist, sexist, homophobic/transphobic, or vulgar content will not be tolerated and will result in immediate removal of artist from the event.

Disclaimer:

Due to COVID-19, there is a possibility the festival will be a virtual event as circumstances are considered closer to the event date. As of now, it seems the response to COVID-19 is on track to allow for an in-person event with reduced capacity, but please be aware this is subject to change. **The final decision will be announced 45 days prior to the event (5/11/21).** We appreciate your flexibility and understanding.

If feasible, the festival will take place outdoors at the MacAllister Amphitheater and surrounding grounds at Garfield Park. CDC guidelines (reduced capacity, mask requirements, blocked seating, etc.) will be followed to maintain the safety of artists, employees, volunteers, and attendees. If we feel the event should be changed to a virtual event, we will work with artists to promote their online shops/websites through paid advertising (booth fee would also be subject to change).

In the case of rain, the event will still take place, but the event will be relocated to the Corporate Shelter Pavilion and the Garfield Park Arts Center.

The Artist Selection Committee of GPAMF will take submissions **until FRIDAY, April 30, 2021**, and artists will be contacted shortly after regarding their acceptance into the event. Please direct any questions and all applications to GPAC@Indy.Gov.
