### **Deadline to Apply: April 30, 2021**

The fourth annual Garfield Park Art & Music Festival (GPAMF) will be held on Saturday, June 26 from 4-10 PM at the Garfield Park MacAllister Amphitheater and will feature local artists and musicians from Indianapolis. To be considered for this limited lineup, **reply to [gpamf.indy@gmail.com](mailto:gpamf.indy@gmail.com) with the following information:**

1. Group name
2. A short bio/description of your act (*300-500 words*)
3. Group website (if applicable)
4. 2-3 video links of live performances
5. Any social media sites
6. Name, email, and phone number of main contact
7. Sound/stage tech needs

#### **Guidelines to be considered for the festival lineup:**

1. Artists who are Indianapolis-based or from the surrounding counties only, please.
2. Be available on Saturday, June 26 from 4-10 PM for the festival and organization of sound needs at the Garfield Park Amphitheater, plus additional setup and teardown time as needed for your set.
3. Have at least 30 mins of material (original music only) to perform.
4. Be okay with performing live **or** virtually.
5. Comply with CDC recommendations as outlined in our COVID-19 safety plan (see below).
6. Be willing to promote on behalf of the festival.

7. Any acts with racist, sexist, homophobic/transphobic, or vulgar lyricism/attitudes need not apply.

**Disclaimer:**

**Due to COVID-19, there is a possibility the festival will be a virtual event as circumstances are considered closer to the event date.** As of now, it seems the response to COVID-19 is on track to allow for an in-person event with reduced capacity, but please be aware this is subject to change. **The final decision will be announced 45 days prior to the event (5/11/21).** We appreciate your flexibility and understanding.

Guarantee will be calculated based on time slot/set time and artist influence. Each act can expect to be paid a fair amount for a modest, local festival. Exact amount will be discussed upon submission acceptance.

If feasible, the festival will take place outdoors at the MacAllister Amphitheater at Garfield Park. CDC guidelines (reduced capacity, mask requirements, blocked seating, etc.) will be followed to maintain the safety of artists, employees, volunteers, and attendees. If we feel the event should be changed to a virtual event, recording of the performances will also take place at the MacAllister Amphitheater.

In the case of rain, the event will still take place, but the stage will be relocated to the Corporate Shelter Pavilion near the Garfield Park Arts Center.
